14. Councilmember Martin requested a follow-up from Chief Turner, on behalf of Mr. Steve Carr, regarding the creation of a police relation with the community task force. Staff has sent an email to Chief Turner and his staff. Currently waiting for a response.

15. Councilmember Norwood requested an update from APD regarding the licensing and permitting procedure for Anchor Down Grill and Lounge and information regarding public safety issues at the location.
