**Dept. of Public Works is following up on this request, Should be ready to move by December 2, 2015.**

2. Chairperson Moore asked Miguel Southwell, Aviation GM, to be prepared to give a presentation or update on permitting and regulating Transportation Company's like Uber and Lyft at HJAIA, at one of the upcoming Transportation Committee meetings. The presentation should provide a summary of the procedures that will be put in place and should let the committee know if the council will need to introduce legislation.
