WHEREAS, pursuant to City Code Section 2-1852 on May 18, 2017, the City of Atlanta's Municipal Clerk notified the Chair of the Committee on Council that a vacancy to be filled by appointment of the Atlanta City Council existed on the Invest Atlanta Board of Directors in the real estate category (Exhibit A); and

WHEREAS, further pursuant to City Code Section 2-1852, on June 5, 2017, the Chair of the Committee on Council (COC) informed all Council Members that Kirk Rich, previous City Council appointee, had resigned from the board (Exhibit B); and

WHEREAS, on June 5, 2017, Councilmember Howard Shook submitted the name of Mr. Christopher Ahrenkiel for appointment to serve on the Atlanta Development Authority (DBA) Invest Atlanta Board of Directors as the Atlanta City Council real estate category appointee (Exhibit C); and

WHEREAS, on June 5, 2017 Councilmember Kwanza Hall submitted the name of Larry Glasgow, however Mr. Hall later withdrew the nomination during the June 19, 2017 meeting of the Committee on Council; and

WHEREAS, the nomination for appointment of Mr. Christopher Ahrenkiel became the single Council Member nomination, in response to the Committee on Council Chair's notification; and

WHEREAS, further pursuant to City Code Section 2-1852, the Chair of the Committee on Council has caused this resolution to be written; and

WHEREAS, further pursuant to City Code Section 2-1852, Mr. Christopher Ahrenkiel is recommended by the Atlanta City Council for appointment to the Atlanta Development Authority (DBA) Invest Atlanta Board of Directors in the real estate category for a term of four (4) years.
