

**A RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBERS CARLA SMITH, KWANZA HALL, ALEX WAN, MICHAEL JULIAN BOND, NATALYN ARCHIBONG AND IVORY LEE YOUNG JR., AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE DOW CHEMICAL COMPANY THROUGH A PARTNERSHIP WITH KEEP ATLANTA BEAUTIFUL IN THE AMOUNT OF FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$50,000.00) FOR THE PURPOSE OF CREATING A PROGRAM MARKETING PROGRAM TO IDENTIFY SUSTAINABLE PRACTICES AND SOLUTIONS FOR ALL COMMUNITIES THROUGHOUT THE CITY; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, TO ENTER INTO ANY REQUIRED AGREEMENTS FOR PROGRAM PARTICIPATION AND GRANT IMPLEMENTATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.(HELD 7/25/17 AT THE REQUEST OF THE DEPARTMENT)**

WHEREAS, The Dow Chemical Company has partnered with national nonprofit, Keep America Beautiful, to award two \$50,000 grants ("Grant") for organizations to establish a Hefty EnergyBag program ("Program") in their communities; and

WHEREAS, the Program is an innovative approach to diverting traditionally non-recycled plastics - like chip bags and juice pouches -from landfills and converting the materials into valuable energy sources; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta ("City") has a Keep America Beautiful affiliate, the Keep Atlanta Beautiful Commission, that is committed to improving and beautifying our city; and

WHEREAS, the City seeks to achieve multiple outcomes including the development of strong community engagement and leadership, prioritizing equity, involving multiple sectors and disciplines, and demonstrating a high degree of readiness to implement a plan that will increase and improve the sustainability of all communities throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the City, through the Program, will work with various community partners including local Georgia nonprofit organizations with an interest in identifying and implementing sustainable practices; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor's Office of Resilience desires to apply for the Grant in the amount of Fifty Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$50,000.00); and

WHEREAS, it is desirable and in the best interests of the City to participate in the Program and apply for the Grant.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY RESOLVES, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to apply for and accept the Grant in the amount of Fifty Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$50,000.00);

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to enter into any required agreements for Program participation and Grant implementation with The Dow Chemical Company; and


