

A RESOLUTION BY TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HER DESIGNEE, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH WSP USA FOR FC-10311, ARCHITECTURAL AND ENGINEERING SERVICES THE FOR CYCLE ATLANTA 1.0 IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED NINETY NINE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED NINETY FIVE DOLLARS AND FIFTEEN CENTS (\$199,995.15); ALL CONTRACTED WORK TO BE CHARGED TO AND PAID FROM THE FUND, DEPARTMENT, ORGANIZATION AND ACCOUNT NUMBERS LISTED HEREIN; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta (“City”) solicited Request for Qualifications (“RFQ”) from qualified firms for FC-10311, Architectural and Engineering Services (the “Agreement”) for bicycle improvements for Cycle Atlanta 1.0 on behalf of the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, the Cycle Atlanta 1.0 Project (“Project”) will improve bicycle access to six (6) MARTA rail stations and multiple fixed route bus services serving the City by implementing and constructing dedicated and protected bicycle lanes and potentially multi-use paths;

WHEREAS, the initial term of the Agreement is for a period of one (1) year with three (3) additional one (1) year renewal options to be exercised at the City’s sole discretion; and

WHEREAS, the selected firm is Georgia Department of Transportation (“GDOT”) prequalified to perform work in the appropriate area classes, however, due to the FTA funding source, the project will not be required to undergo GDOT’s Plan Development Process (PDP); and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of the Department of Public Works and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend the award of Professional Services Agreement to Stantec Consulting Services Inc., for FC-10311, Architectural and Engineering Services in an amount not to One Hundred Ninety-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-Five Dollars and Fifteen Cents (\$199,995.15); and

WHEREAS, the Chief Procurement Officer certifies that any organizational and personal relationships disclosed by the successful offeror have been processed in accordance with Section 2-1214 of the Procurement Code and that award of the contract is appropriate.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY RESOLVES, that the Mayor, or her designee, is authorized to enter into an agreement with WSP USA FC-10311, Architectural, Engineering for design services for Cycle Atlanta 1.0 Improvement Project, on behalf of the Department of Public Works, in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Ninety-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-Five Dollars and Fifteen Cents (\$199,995.15).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, with all contracted work will be charged to and paid from the following Fund, Department and Account Numbers 2501 (Intergovernmental Grant Fund) 130308 (DPW Transportation Design) 5999999 (Projects and Grants Budget - Summary) 4270000 (Traffic Engineering) 112808 (Cycle Atlanta 1.0 Improvements) 32442 (Cycle Atlanta) - \$199,995.15; PTAEO funding source: 13112808 1** 250132442 5999999 COA.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the initial term of the Agreement is for a period of one (1) years with three (3) additional one (1) year renewal options to be exercised at the City's sole discretion.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Procurement Officer in consultation with the City Attorney, is directed to prepare all appropriate documents for execution by the Mayor, or her designee.

BE FINALLY IT RESOLVED, that the Agreement will not become binding upon the City, and the City shall incur no obligation or liability under it until the Agreement has been approved by the City Attorney as to form, executed by the Mayor, attested to by the Municipal Clerk, and delivered to WSP USA.
