

A RESOLUTION BY PUBLIC SAFETY AND LEGAL ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HER DESIGNEE, ON BEHALF OF THE ATLANTA POLICE DEPARTMENT, TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT THE 2019 BODY-WORN CAMERA POLICY AND IMPLEMENTATION PROGRAM TO SUPPORT LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, BUREAU OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, AND BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE, IN THE AMOUNT OF UP TO THREE MILLION DOLLARS (\$3,000,000), WITH NO MATCHING FUNDS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROMOTING THE SAFETY OF LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS AND CITIZENS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, The FY 2019 Body-Worn Camera Policy and Implementation Program to Support Law Enforcement Agencies “(BWCPIP-LEA)” directly supports key priorities of the Department of Justice by promoting the safety of law enforcement officers and citizens by strengthening the means for evidence capture and by contributing to improved justice outcomes; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has determined that the Atlanta Police Department will better serve the citizens of Atlanta by equipping all members of the department with body worn cameras; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta Police Department is expanding its current deployment of body worn cameras to include investigators, specialized units and retirees; and

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY RESOLVES, that the Mayor, or her designee, is hereby authorized to apply for and accept a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance in the amount up to three million dollars and zero cents (\$3,000,000.00).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this grant from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance will not require a local match.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that all resolutions and parts of resolutions, in conflict herewith are hereby waived to the extent of the conflict.
