LEGISLATION HISTORY - BLUE BACK

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RE-EMPLOYMENT OF CITY RETIREE FRANK MOBLEY IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT OFFICE OF BUILDINGS AS AN OFFICE OF BUILDINGS ARBORIST SR. PURSUANT TO SECTION 3-505 (C) OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Mr. Frank Mobley having served the City of Atlanta for over twenty-five (25) years in various positions in the Office of Buildings including Arborist, Sr. and retired from The City in good standing in October 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Planning and Community Development, Office of Buildings (“OOB”) will be in need of Arborist, Sr. and related Office of Buildings services for a period not to exceed one hundred twenty (120) business days; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Mobley’s previous experience with the City gives him specialized knowledge of arborist plan review to determine whether plans, specifications, workmanship, and materials conform to legally established requirements. Additionally, Mr. Mobley possesses thorough understanding of OOB’s arbor-culturist programs encompassing research, evaluation, cultivation, propagation, care and maintenance activities of trees and woody species within the specialized area of arboriculture; and

WHEREAS, section 3-505 (c) of the Charter of the City of Atlanta authorizes that the City may re-employ a retiree for any single period of time, or any several period of time, which shall not exceed five hundred and twenty (520) business days, whether continuously or in separate days of employment, for the purpose of availing the City of some particularized skill possessed by said retiree; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Planning and Community Development, Office of Buildings and Mr. Frank Mobley have mutually agreed to his re-employment as Arborist, Sr.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, that:

SECTION 1: The Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to re-employ Mr. Frank Mobley in the Office of Buildings as an Arborist, Sr. in an extra help capacity without benefits, for a period not to exceed one hundred twenty (120) business days at grade 20, at a yearly rate of \$64,575.65 as authorized by Section 3-505 (c) of the Charter of the city of Atlanta, said re-employment to begin December 2015.
