A RESOLUTION BY ALEX WAN TO SUPPORT LIVE THRIVE ATLANTA'S "CHARMING EVENING" BENEFIT ON MARCH 10, 2016; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Live Thrive Atlanta (“Live Thrive”) is an Atlanta-based nonprofit organization whose mission is to empower people, organizations, communities, and businesses to make positive, healthy, and sustainable changes to the environment; and

WHEREAS, Live Thrive organized the first household hazardous waste collection in the City of Atlanta (“City”) in 2010. Seven additional events were organized and the need for a permanent drop-off facility for hard to recycle materials was realized; and

WHEREAS, the Center for Hard to Recycle Materials (“CHaRM”) is a permanent facility, located in Southeast Atlanta, that encourages reuse, while diverting thousands of pounds of household hazardous waste, bulky trash and other hard to recycle items from households, landfills, and the water supply; and

WHEREAS, CHaRM benefits the City by providing a facility that is easily accessible and convenient, accepts a wide range of items that are acceptable through typical curbside recycling, and provides educational sessions about the importance of proper disposal of hard to recycle materials; and

WHEREAS, Live Thrive is hosting “ A CHaRMing Evening” on Thursday, March 10, 2016, at Piedmont Park’s Greystone to support Live Thrive’s CHaRM Initiative; and

WHEREAS, the City appreciative of the efforts of Live Thrive to create a more sustainable Atlanta and desires to support its “A CHaRMing Evening” event.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, that the Atlanta City Council supports Live Thrive Atlanta’s “A CHaRMing Evening” to be held on Thursday, March 10, 2016.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Atlanta City Council supports any efforts made by the City to assist this event and the activities of Live Thrive Atlanta.
