ATLANTA; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the new economy is defined as new, high-growth industries that are on the cutting edge of technology and are the driving force of economic growth; and

WHEREAS, these jobs may be found in such sectors as healthcare, information technology, restaurant and food services, business, social work, and education; and

WHEREAS, other industries include the 'sharing economy', which refers to peer-to-peer-based sharing of access to goods and services; and

WHEREAS, retaining these jobs and making them available to residents of the City of Atlanta is of the utmost importance to our City's economy, but also to our future and overall quality of life; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to create a Commission to collaborate with leaders from the business industry, government, and education to review best practices from around the country and provide recommendations on growing and retaining new economy jobs in the City of Atlanta.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, that the Commission for Jobs in the New Economy consisting of Nineteen (19) members is hereby established.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commission on Jobs in the New Economy shall include the following members:

- Two (2) members shall be appointed by the Mayor
- One (1) Member shall be appointed by the Council President
- The Councilmember from Council District 2
- The Post 1 At-Large Councilmember
- One (1) member shall be appointed by Council Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, and Post 1 At- Large
- One (1) member shall be appointed by Council Districts 5, 6, 7, 8 and Post 2 At-Large
- One (1) member shall be appointed by Council Districts 9, 10, 11, 12 and Post 3 At-Large
- The Executive Director of the Atlanta Workforce Development Agency, or his designee
- One (1) member shall be appointed by the Interim Executive Director of Invest Atlanta, or their designee

- One (1) Member shall be appointed by the Commissioner of the Georgia Department of Labor
- One (1) member shall be appointed by the Atlanta Chamber of Commerce
- One (1) member shall be appointed by the Georgia Department of Economic Development
- One(1) member shall be appointed by the Atlanta North Georgia Labor Council
- Two (2) members shall be appointed by local nonprofit agencies that have experience in job training and/or job readiness
- One (1) Member shall be appointed by the Atlanta Board of Education
- One (1) Member shall be appointed by the President of Atlanta Metropolitan State College
- One (1) Member shall be appointed by the President of Georgia State University

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Office of Municipal Clerk is hereby directed to notify the above individuals and organizations to request that the names of their nominees be submitted to the Office of Municipal Clerk.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commission on Jobs in the New Economy shall meet at least Four (4) times annually, and all meetings shall be open to the public.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Community Development/Human Resources Committee Staff shall provide technical assistance and staffing to the Commission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commission on Jobs in the New Economy shall submit a report annually to the Community Development/Human Resources Committee.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict are hereby rescinded.
