1. Please provide a summary of the purpose of this legislation (Justification Statement).

This legislation authorizes the Mayor or his designee on behalf of the City of Atlanta to file with the Federal Aviation Administration (the "FAA") an Amendment for authorization to continue to impose a Passenger Facility Charge ("PFC") on each enplaned revenue passenger at Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport.

2. Please provide background information regarding this legislation.

The City of Atlanta owns and operates Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport (the "Airport") and under the Aviation Safety and Capacity Expansion Act of 1990, applied to the "FAA for authorization to impose and use" PFCs for certain Projects in the Airport's Capital Improvement Plan in PFC Application No. 17. On October 19, 2015, the FAA approved PFCs for impose and use in PFC Application No. 17. Since then, one Project in PFC Application No. 17 – Passenger-Loading Bridge Replacement and Refurbishment – have changed in both Scope and Budget and it is now necessary to authorize an Amendment to be submitted to the FAA and other required steps and actions to be taken on behalf of the City to complete the amendment process. The amendment proposes to modify the Scope and Budget for Passenger-Loading Bridge Replacement and Refurbishment to now include the planning, design and installation of (116 replacement Passenger-Loading Bridges, 129 400Hz Aircraft Ground Power Units and 79 Preconditioned Air Units at the Airport. The refurbishing of 30 Passenger-Loading Bridges has been deleted from this Project. The Project now also includes the work necessary to address Nation Fire Protection Associations issues identified in the "Life Safety Study" at each affected gate (approximately 70) to ensure compliance with Code 415 and 101.
