**A RESOLUTION

AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC SAFETY AND LEGAL ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE**

**A RESOLUTION TO EXTEND THE CODE ENFORCEMENT COMMISSION FOR  
TWENTY-FOUR (24) MONTHS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the Code Enforcement Commission ("Commission") was established for a period of twelve (12) months pursuant to Resolution 14-R-3671, adopted by the Atlanta City Council on June 16, 2014 and approved on June 25, 2014 per City Charter Section 2-403 for the purpose of restoring the quality of life of Atlanta Communities and determining best practices to further combat habitual violators of the Atlanta Housing Code, both commercial and residential; and

**WHEREAS**, since September 2014, the Commission has been meeting and hearing updates from the various entities which are involved in the Code Enforcement in the City of Atlanta, Fulton County and Dekalb County; and

**WHEREAS**, per Resolution 14-R-3671, the Commission was terminated June 26, 2015, but wished to be extended to continue hearing from the various entities that are providing overviews and recommendations based on best practices; and

**WHEREAS**, per Resolution 15-R-3915, the Commission was extended for a period of twelve (12) months, effective retroactively from June 26, 2015 through June 25, 2016.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Code Enforcement Commission is extended for a period of twenty-four (24) months, effective retroactively from June 26, 2016 through  
June 25, 2018.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Commission will be staffed by staff of the sponsor councilmembers' offices.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that all resolutions and parts of resolutions, in conflict herewith are waived to the extent of the conflict.
