RE: Request for Nominations to the Development Impact Fee Advisory Committee

DATE: January 22, 2019

Pursuant to City Code Section 2-1852, please accept this written notice regarding three (3) upcoming vacancies on the Development Impact Fee Advisory Committee to be filled by appointment of the City Council.

The Development Impact Fee Advisory Committee was established pursuant to Ordinance 18-O-1764, adopted by the Atlanta City Council on January 7, 2019. The Committee shall serve in an advisory capacity to assist and advise the Council with regard to the adopted or an amendment to the City's development impact fee ordinance or any new development impact fee ordinance. They will also receive the annual report required by O.C.G.A. 36-71-8(d)(2) and, if warranted upon review of the annual report, submit a written report to the Council of any perceived inequities in the expenditure of impact fees collected for roads, streets, bridges, including rights of way, traffic signals, landscaping, or any local components of state or federal highways. Finally, pursuant to O.C.G.A. §36-71-5(c), no action of the committee shall be considered a necessary prerequisite for action by the Council in regard to the adoption of a development impact fee ordinance.

The Committee shall consist of five (5) members to be confirmed by Council: two (2) to be appointed by the Mayor and three (3) to be appointed by Council. At least three (3) of the Committee members shall be representatives from the development, building, or real estate industries.

Please provide your nominations, ***which meet the criteria of being representatives from the development, building, or real estate industries***, to me and Julia Pulidindi at jrpulidindi@atlantaga.gov no later than Tuesday, January 29, 2019 at 5:00 pm. If more than three (3) nominations are received, a ballot vote will be conducted at the February 4, 2019 Full Council meeting to finalize the nominations.
