

**A SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE  
BY COMMITTEE ON COUNCIL**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CITY OF ATLANTA CODE OF ORDINANCES SECTION 66-2 "PRECINCT BOUNDARY LINES AND POLLING PLACES" BY AMENDING THE 2017 PRECINCTS AND POLLING PLACES ORDINANCE IN FULTON COUNTY PRECINCTS 11B, 01J, 09B, 11R DUE TO THE COURT OF APPEALS REVERSED DECISION AND APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF LOCH LOMOND SUBDIVISION INTO THE CITY OF SOUTH FULTON; NAME CHANGE OF FACILITY; PERMANENTLY MOVING PRECINCTS TO EXTEND PHYSICAL SPACE AND PARKING SPACES OF POLLING FACILITIES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the 2017 Precincts and Polling Places Ordinance was adopted by the Atlanta City Council on December 04, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, such Precincts and Polling Place Ordinance has previously been amended by action of the City Council on March 05, 2018; March 18, 2019; May 20, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fulton County Board of Registration and Elections has approved changes to City of Atlanta Precincts/Polling Places 11B, 01J, 09B, 11R; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fulton County Department of Registration and Elections has notified the City of certain changes to City of Atlanta Precincts/Polling Places 11B, 01J, 09B, 11R; and

**WHEREAS**, affected voters shall be notified of these changes by Fulton County Board of Registration and Elections, and

**WHEREAS**, the governing authority of the City of Atlanta, the Atlanta City Council, believes that ratification of these changes should be made by this Body.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** that the Atlanta City Council does hereby ratify the previous authorization and approval by the Fulton County Board of Registration and Elections of changes to Precincts/Polling Places 11B, 01J, 09B, 11R making changes to said precincts due to the court of appeals reversed decision and approving the annexation of Loch Lomond subdivision into the City of South Fulton, name change of facility, permanently moving precincts to extend physical space and parking spaces of polling facilities; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that the Atlanta City Council does hereby amend the 2017 precincts and polling places ordinance, adopted by the Council on December 4, 2017 (codified as section 66-2 of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances; and adopted by reference) by adding the recent changes to precincts/polling places 11B, 01J, 09B, 11R; and

**BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED** that certain changes identified and described above, detailed below and further identified by the attachments shown as Exhibits A, B, C, D which are reflected

or incorporated in the August 05, 2019 Revision to the 2017 Precincts and Polling Places Ordinance, as shown in Attachment I to this Ordinance, with all being made a part hereof and noted as follows:

**SECTION 1:** To amend Precinct/Polling Place 11B located at Ralph Bunche Middle School, 1925 Niskey Lake Road, SW by adjusting precinct lines for the City of Atlanta of said district accordingly impacted by the Appeals Order as shown in the attached Exhibit A. All affected voters to be notified of this change by first-class mail sent by Fulton County.

**SECTION 2:** To amend Precinct/Polling Place 01J located at Southeast Library, 1463 Pryor Road, SW by changing the name of said precinct to reflect the current name of Louise Watley Library at Southeast Atlanta as shown in the attached Exhibit B. All affected voters to be notified of this change by first-class mail sent by Fulton County.

**SECTION 3:** To amend Precinct/Polling Place 09B located at English Park Recreation Center, 1340 Bolton Road, SW by permanently moving said precinct to Coretta Scott King Young Women's Leadership Academy, 1190 Northwest Drive, NW due to the existing polling location having limited parking as shown in the attached Exhibit C. All affected voters to be notified of this change by first-class mail sent by Fulton County.

**SECTION 4:** To amend Precinct/Polling Place 11R located at Therrell D. M. High School, 3099 Panther Trail, SW by permanently moving said precinct to Mount Carmel Baptist Church, 2755 Campbellton Road, NW due to a need to better serve voters as a significant number of voters were assigned to the existing facility as shown in the attached Exhibit D. All affected voters to be notified of this change by first-class mail sent by Fulton County.

**SECTION 5:** That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
