

A RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBERS MICHAEL JULIAN BOND, ALEX WAN, MARY NORWOOD, ANDRE DICKENS AND KWANZA HALL TO CREATE A COMMITTEE TO CONDUCT A STUDY ON THE USAGE OF PRIVATELY HELD PARKING SPACES IN MIDTOWN ATLANTA FOR A PERIOD OF 120 DAYS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Midtown Atlanta is geographically located in the center of Atlanta and is a dense, pedestrian-friendly, mixed-use district; and

WHEREAS, the Midtown Core supports 43,000 daytime workers, 13,000 residents, and more than 9 million annual visitors to the area's thriving arts/cultural institutions, restaurants, and retail destinations; and

WHEREAS, while Midtown has significant transit infrastructure, the growth pattern of the region and its lack of transit options means many users of Midtown will continue to access the district by motor vehicle and require a place to park; and

WHEREAS, Midtown Alliance conducted an analysis (*Midtown Parking Assessment and Action Plan*) of the current parking system with stakeholder input, and a review of national best management practices; and

WHEREAS, by assessing both off-street and on-street parking assets, the *Midtown Parking Assessment and Action Plan* provides insight into opportunities to make more efficient use of existing parking assets, to reduce the demand for parking, to add parking if necessary, and to explore policy changes that address parking and access challenges; and

WHEREAS, the inventory conducted for the *Midtown Parking Assessment and Action Plan* found that 64,795 parking spaces exist in the Midtown Core (over 97% are located off-street); and

WHEREAS, there are currently no publicly owned and operated off-street parking facilities (off-street parking costs, enforcement, and regulations depend on individual property owners and parking management companies); and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to create a study group to discuss creating an entity that could potentially regulate the usage of privately held parking spaces in Midtown Atlanta.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to create a study group to discuss creating an entity that could potentially regulate the usage of privately held parking spaces in Midtown Atlanta.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, that the Midtown Parking Study Group consisting of Seventeen (17) members is hereby established.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Midtown Parking Study Group shall include the following members:

- One (1) Member shall be appointed by the Mayor
- One (1) Member shall be appointed by Council President
- One (1) member shall be appointed by Post 1 At-Large Councilmember
- One (1) member shall be appointed by Post 2 At-Large Councilmember
- One (1) member shall be appointed by Council District 2
- One (1) member shall be appointed by Council District 6
- One (1) member shall be appointed by NPU' s E, M, and F respectively
- One (1) member shall be appointed by Midtown Alliance
- One (1) member shall be appointed by Lanier Parking
- One (1) member shall be appointed by AAA Parking
- One (1) member shall be appointed by Parkmobile
- The Chief Financial Officer, or his designee
- The Commissioner of the Department of Public Works, or his designee
- The Chief of Atlanta Police Department, or his designee
- One (1) member shall be appointed by AP AB

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Office of Municipal Clerk is hereby directed to notify the above individuals and organizations to request that the names of their nominees be submitted to the Office of Municipal Clerk.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Midtown Parking Study Group shall sunset 120 days from the date of its first meeting.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict with the terms of this resolution are hereby repealed only to the extent of conflict.


