

A RESOLUTION BY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT/HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, TO ACCEPT THE PUBLIC ART INSTALLATION OF “ONE WOMAN RISING” IN FREEDOM PARK FROM THE CHELKO FOUNDATION; AND TO ENTER INTO A MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT FOR MAINTAINING THE PUBLIC ART; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta (“City”) has various works of public art throughout the Atlanta (the “Artwork”); and

WHEREAS, The Chelko Foundation desires to install public art in Freedom Park; and

WHEREAS, The Chelko Foundation and the Office of Parks, Department of Parks and Recreation have agreed on a location for the art donation, a schedule for maintenance and responsible party for funding the care of the art donation; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Cultural Affairs, Public Art Program finds that this art fits within the context of the City of Atlanta’s art collection and deemed a benefit to the City; and

WHEREAS, after the installation of the artwork, the Office of Cultural Affairs will document the installation, schedule the routine maintenance and advise on the conservation treatments; and

WHEREAS, this artwork will be promoted as an asset in Atlanta’s Public Art Collection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, AS FOLLOWS, that the Mayor, on behalf of the City is hereby authorized to accept the artwork and enter into a Maintenance Agreement in substantially similar form to the document attached hereto as Exhibit A with The Chelko Foundation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Attorney or her designee is hereby authorized to prepare the Maintenance Agreement for execution by the Mayor.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Maintenance Agreement shall not become binding upon the City, and the City shall incur neither obligation nor liability thereunder, until the same has been approved as to form by the City attorney, signed by the Mayor, attested to by the Municipal Clerk and delivered to The Chelko Foundation.
