A RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBER KWANZA HALL AS SUBSTITUTED BY FINANCE/EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ENTER INTO A REVISED SECOND AGREEMENT WITH THE ATLANTA DOWNTOWN IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT (“ADID”) IN ORDER TO REPLACE AN AGREEMENT ORIGINALLY ENTERED INTO BETWEEN THE CITY AND THE ADID ON DECEMBER 30, 2013, THAT EXPIRED ON DECEMBER 31, 2013, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THREE HUNDRED TWENTY TWO THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED FIFTY NINE DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$322,159.00) FOR ONGOING ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR THE HIGH-PRIORITY BICYCLE PROJECTS ON PEACHTREE STREET AND ON PEACHTREE CENTER AVENUE BETWEEN EDGEWOOD AVENUE AND PEACHTREE STREET; ALL WORK TO BE CHARGED TO AND PAID FROM ACCOUNT NUMBERS AS LISTED HEREIN; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, ARTICLE IX, SECTION VII of the 1983 Constitution of the State of Georgia authorizes municipalities to create community improvement districts and pursuant to the “Atlanta Community Improvement District Act”, enacted by the Georgia General Assembly as House Bill 544, 1991 Ga. Laws 3653, the City of Atlanta created the Atlanta Downtown Improvement District (ADID) pursuant to the constitutional and statutory authority cited herein (Resolution 95-R-1374, as supplemented by Resolution 02-R-0241); and

WHEREAS, City Council Resolution 95-R-1374 authorized the ADID to provide such services as the construction and maintenance of local, collector and arterial streets as shown on the City’s street classification map or as otherwise included in the City’s most recently adopted Comprehensive Development Plan, including curbs, sidewalks, street lights and devices to control the flow of traffic on local, collector and arterial streets; and

WHEREAS, the ADID is authorized to contract with the City pursuant to the constitutional and statutory authority above referenced; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta has previously entered into agreements authorizing the ADID to undertake Quality of Life, Georgia Department of Transportation, and other infrastructure projects under a standardized agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City now wishes to undertake certain high-priority bicycle projects on Peachtree Street and Peachtree Center Avenue in downtown Atlanta (the “Projects”) as more particularly described on Exhibit “A” the Project Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City and the ADID believe that a public partnership to complete the projects offers unique opportunities to significantly improve mobility in the downtown Atlanta area; and

WHEREAS, City Council Ordinance 12-O-1674 appropriated funding for design and construction of the Projects; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to participate in the project by providing funds to ADID for ongoing engineering and construction services in an amount no to exceed Three Hundred Twenty Two Thousand One Hundred Fifty Nine Dollars and No Cents (\$322,159.00); and

WHEREAS, to ensure completion of these ongoing engineering and construction services and to reimburse design and construction expenses for the Project to the ADID, a new project agreement shall reflect a new expiration date of December 31, 2016.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA HEREBY RESOLVES that the Mayor, or his designee, on behalf of the City, is hereby authorized to provide funds in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Twenty Two Thousand One Hundred Fifty Nine Dollars and No Cents (\$322,159.00) to the Atlanta Downtown Improvement District to be used toward ongoing engineering and construction of the Projects as substantially set forth in Exhibit "A".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, to ensure completion of ongoing engineering and construction services and to reimburse design and construction expenses for the Project to the ADID, the Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", shall reflect a new expiration date of December 31, 2016.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that all contracted work will be charged to and paid from the following Fund, Department and Account Numbers 3503 (Capital Finance Fund) 130308 (DPW Transportation Design) 5414002 (Facilities other than Bldgs/Infrastructure-CIP) 4270000 (Traffic Engineering) 110071 (Bicycle Route Sign & Marks) 1** 350322037 22037 (Repurposed Bond Proceeds 2012) - \$322,159.00.
