

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE LAND USE ELEMENT OF THE 2011
CITY OF ATLANTA COMPREHENSIVE DEVELOPMENT PLAN (CDP)
SO AS TO DESIGNATE PROPERTY TO LAND USE DESIGNATION
IDENTIFIED HEREIN; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, certain resident electors and the owners of real property have petitioned the City of Atlanta for annexation from unincorporated Fulton County to the corporate limits of the City of Atlanta; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the Fulton County land use designation is the appropriate designation for the properties.

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA HEREBY ORDAINS
AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. That the 2011 City of Atlanta Comprehensive Development Plan (CDP) is hereby amended by changing the Land Use Element of said Plan so as to designate property, as more fully delineated on Exhibit "A" and which is incorporated herein by reference, to the compatible Fulton County land use designation.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or parts of Ordinances that are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby waived to the extent of the conflict.
