

**A SUBSTITUTED RESOLUTION BY
FINANCE/EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RE-EMPLOYMENT OF CITY OF ATLANTA RETIREE, MS. ALMITRA LOVE IN THE POSITION OF CRIME SCENE UNIT MANAGER, IN THE ATLANTA POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR COMPENSATION NOT TO EXCEED FIFTY THREE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED THIRTEEN DOLLARS AND EIGHTY-TWO CENTS (\$53,413.82), PURSUANT TO SECTION 3-505(c) OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Ms. Almitra Love having served the City of Atlanta (“City”) for more than 30 years and will retire in good standing in June 2016; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Love has specialized knowledge and expertise in managing our Automated Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS); and

WHEREAS, Ms. Love also supervises our Crime Scene Technician Unit; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department desires to re-employ Ms. Love based on her considerable knowledge and expertise to provide supervision over our entire Crime Scene Unit, for a period of two hundred twenty days in an amount not to exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$53,413.82); and

WHEREAS, Section 3-505(c) of the Charter of the City of Atlanta authorizes the re-employment of a retiree for any single period of time, or any several periods of time, which shall not exceed 520 business days, whether continuously or in separate days of employment, for the purpose of availing the City of some particularized skill possessed by said retiree; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, that the City is authorized to employ Ms. Love as a Crime Scene Unit Manager, in the Police Department in an extra-help capacity without benefits, for a period not to exceed two hundred twenty (220) days, and for compensation not to exceed fifty three thousand, four hundred thirteen dollars and eighty two cents (\$53,413.82) as authorized pursuant to Section 3-505(c) of the City of Charter.
