

**A SUBSTITUTE RESOLUTION  
BY FINANCE/EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RE-EMPLOYMENT OF CITY OF ATLANTA RETIREE, MR. HORACE REID IN THE POSITION OF COMMUNICATION ELECTRONIC TECHNICIAN SUPERVISOR, IN THE ATLANTA POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR COMPENSATION NOT TO EXCEED FIFTY FIVE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED THIRTY SEVEN DOLLARS AND FORTY FOUR CENTS (\$55,937.44) PURSUANT TO SECTION 3-505(c) OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Horace Reid having served the City of Atlanta (“City”) for more than 30 years retired in good standing in May 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Reid has specialized knowledge and expertise of the communication systems used within the City of Atlanta and by outside jurisdictions; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Reid other supervisor duties includes providing electronic technical service for all radio, in-car video, network license plate readers, laptop computers and alarm systems; and

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department desires to re-employ Mr. Reid based on his considerable knowledge and expertise to provide technical assistance in supervising our Electronic Maintenance Unit, for a period of two hundred twenty days in an amount not to exceed fifty five thousand, nine hundred thirty seven dollars and forty four cents (\$55,937.44); and

**WHEREAS**, Section 3-505(c) of the Charter of the City of Atlanta authorizes the re-employment of a retiree for any single period of time, or any several periods of time, which shall not exceed 520 business days, whether continuously or in separate days of employment, for the purpose of availing the City of some particularized skill possessed by said retiree; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA**, that the City is authorized to employ Mr. Reid as a Communication Electronic Technician Supervisor, in Police Department in an extra-help capacity without benefits, for a period not to exceed two hundred twenty (220) days, and for compensation not to exceed fifty five thousand, nine hundred thirty seven dollars and forty four cents (\$55,937.44); as authorized pursuant to Section 3-505(c) of the City of Charter.
